Two adjacent condominium apartments were combined into a single 2,500 sf residence in a Mies Van der Rohe high rise building overlooking Lincoln Park and Lake Michigan. Primary living spaces are organized around an internal core containing bathrooms, wet bar and storage areas. The existing kitchen expands to incorporate a breakfast area within a sculptural glass block wall.

The major living areas are oriented towards views overlooking the park and lakefront. Curved soffits and walls combine with glass block and lighting highlights to encourage a continuous spatial flow. Primary materials include marble and white oak flooring, custom millwork, granite counters and glass block walls.
